**MINUTES**

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Pledge was lead by Darrin Webster.
- Council Attendees: Kay Dickerson, Jeremy Christensen, Lenelle Sanchez, Christy Seiger-Webster, Darrin Webster, Richard Snow, Cody Cutler, and Paulina Flint.
- Council Excused: Linda Price
- Council Not Excused: none
- Visitors: none
- Approval of March 6th, 2013 Minutes- motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer's report-Jeremy Christensen gave the financial reports for March 2013. There was no change in the accounts. Treasurer's report motion, seconded, and approved.
- Unified Police Report- Officer Green provided data for March 2013. Report on the vandalism at the White City Water offices: encourage citizens to increase observance of activity outside of business hours. Discussed illegal parking concerns especially of RV's in the streets with people staying in them.
  - Data provided by Officer Green: Total Calls: 152; Total Cases: 40
- Mayor's Report-Greg Schultz and Joel Freston. Delivered checks to the Treasurer. Joel reported on the meeting with Granite Peaks Community Council regarding proposed annexation. Discussed proposed change to the justice courts where they will be regionalized and the municipalities will collect and run the court. The county currently controls this and runs a significant deficit. Concerns were: (1) who will be held responsible if it runs a deficit; (2) the contract must be set up such that it does not provide "services" and thus impact the status of the community council status (i.e. allow for annexation by cities).
- ACCT Report- ACCT training was moved to May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2013 at 7am at the Salt Lake County complex.
- Southeast Township Days: Need to place deposit on a radio station ASAP. Approved Station 106.5, since 94.1 is already booked elsewhere. Need a draft contract from Diamond Rental. Looking into other attractions than the car show, such as motorcycles, mountain men, or sports celebrities.
- Other news: Discussed the GRAMA request for fire service budget details from Sandy City, paying \$750,000 /year. Greg suggested appealing to the fire board regarding high costs. Leave on the agenda for May \* Several of the White City monuments have been vandalized or damaged. Kay and Cody will try various paint removers on the graffiti and try cement repairs for damaged bricks. \* The new carwash in the Quarry Bend area also includes a lube/oil/filter and gas station. Will this impact White City Water? Paulina will discuss next month. \* Discussed potentially moving future council meeting dates if conflicting with non-governmental holidays (i.e. religious or fun events). Decided to continue as before with only moving if conflicting with government holidays (i.e. Independence Day), motion, seconded, and approved.
