- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. No flag was available for the pledge.

- Approval of July 17th, 2013 Minutes- motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer's report- Accounts are all up to date. Township Days accounts are in good shape for the upcoming event. Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Unified Police Report- Attending: Dave Scharff

- Mayor's Report- Attending: Joel Freston, Will Becker, Todd Draper
 - Stacey Adams is the new Communications Officer for SE Townships
 - A new position has been proposed for SE Townships Economic Development.
 - Mayor McAdams wants to attend our meeting in Sept/Oct. Council suggested Sept.
 - The county has produced a new bicycle planning/policy document. Comments should be given to Kay by the September meeting for him to submit. Support of the intent of the document was motion, seconded, and approved.
- ACCT Report-
 - No ACCT meeting in July. August meeting hasn't occurred yet.
- Southeast Township Days:
 - Budget is in good shape.
 - Banners need to go up. Check them out at Paulina's house.
 - Setup starts at 10a.
- Municipal Priorities:
 - Gwynth and Marissa, representing the PTA from Edgemont, discussed safe walking and other traffic concerns on Galena. Suggested the PTA formally request a traffic study on Galena.
 - Kay and Christy provided a municipal improvements list. Council determined that these items would be the basis for the upcoming year's request. Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Other news:
 - No further response on the GRAMA request for fire service budget details from Sandy City, paying \$750,000 /year. Greg suggested appealing to the fire board regarding high costs.

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- Sandy is considering pulling out of the emergency call center. A letter was sent out to SLCo and Unified Fire to cancel the first responders contract. *Leave on the agenda.*
- Several of the White City monuments have been vandalized or damaged. No further repairs have been completed. The cement repairs and damaged bricks will be coordinated with the water company, which has lifting equipment. *Leave on the agenda.*
- Westbound 10600 South at 1300 East has had an island installed which is causing a traffic hazard from people trying to get into or out of the McDonald's and Chevron on the Northwest corner of the intersection. Sandy City is responsible for this intersection and road area. Letter of concern should be sent to Patrick at SLCo to discuss with Sandy City. Discussion tabled until next meeting. *Leave on the agenda.*
- Concerns of illegal occupancy and drug activity taking place at a home on Flint Drive was reported to the Council. Kay will contact Brooks Green at the Unified Police.
- White City Water has been notified about an increase in fees from the State water board. Council motion: "The State agency should go through appropriations of the stat instead of fees to local agencies." Seconded and approved.
- Meeting was adjourned at 9:16 pm.
