- Approval of June 5th, 2013 Minutes- motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer's report- All funds on track. Motion seconded and approved.
- Unified Police Report- Attending: Brooks Green, Charlotte Halverson
 - Data provided electronically by Officer Green: Total Calls: 212; Total Cases: 48
 - Can report illegal fireworks to the police and they will investigate.
- Mayor's Report- Attending: none.

- ACCT Report-
 - No ACCT meeting in July
- Southeast Township Days:
 - Budget is in good shape.
 - SE Township Days received \$1000 from the video contest. Contest sponsor, Rio Tinto, decided to split the money between all entries.
 - The newsletter was sent out. Need volunteers for judging the car show and for setting up booths.
- Municipal Priorities:
 - Stormwater flooding occurred on Amaryllis around July 13th. SLCo has been notified and sandbags will be provided to the homeowners. SLCo public works is aware of the drainage issue and is adding this area to a current project.
 - Council members should add stormwater drainage issues to their municipal priorities report, due at the August meeting. The report should include: sidewalk damage, ADA issues, traffic issues, stormwater issues, and lighting issues.
- Other news:
 - No further response on the GRAMA request for fire service budget details from Sandy City, paying \$750,000 /year. Greg suggested appealing to the fire board regarding high costs. Leave on the agenda.
 - Sandy is considering pulling out of the emergency call center. A letter was sent out to SLCo and Unified Fire to cancel the first responders contract.
 - Several of the White City monuments have been vandalized or damaged. No further repairs have been completed. The cement repairs and damaged bricks will be coordinated with the water company, which has lifting equipment

- Ron Faerber, from Sandy Hills Community Council, discussed setting up a southeast Community Emergency Response Team (CERT), to liason with the County and other municipality CERT teams. Motion was made to join with the other councils in forming a CERT team. Motion was seconded and approved.
- Westbound 10600 South at 1300 East has had an island installed which is causing a traffic hazard from people trying to get into or out of the McDonald's and Chevron on the Northwest corner of the intersection. Sandy City is responsible for this intersection and road area. Letter of concern should be sent to Patrick at SLCo to discuss with Sandy City. Discussion tabled until August meeting.
- SLCo is setting up a preschool program for low income households with Granite School District. WCT will not see any of these services.
- SLCo is doing a Recycle and Sustainability survey. WCT does not do any separate actions from SLCo.
- SLCo is holding a meeting on a 5-yr transportation plan on August 1st at the SLCo offices from 3-5 p.m.
- White City Water has been notified about an increase in fees from the State water board.
