MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Pledge was lead by Darrin Webster.
- Council Attendees: Kay Dickerson, Linda Price, Christy Seiger-Webster, Darrin Webster, Richard Snow, Jeremy Christensen, and Paulina Flint.
- Council Excused: Cody Cutler
- Council Not Excused: Lenelle Sanchez,
- Visitors: Don Dumas, Janice Dumas
- Approval of May 1st, 2013 Minutes- motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer's report- Received checks from Willow Creek for SE Township Days. Report for April and May motion for approval, seconded and approved. Motion made to allow online access by executive officers to US Bank accounts for reporting purposes only. Motion seconded and approved.
- Unified Police Report- Attending: Brooks Green, Charlotte Halverson
 - Data provided electronically by Officer Green: Total Calls: 173; Total Cases: 49
 - Increase in daytime burglaries, particularly garage door entry. Remind constituents to secure the interior door and close the garage door.
- Mayor's Report- Attending: Greg Schultz.
 - Joel Freston excused. He is at the Granite Peaks council meeting, due to the annexation proposal by Sandy.
 - Discussed proposed change to the justice courts where they will be regionalized and the municipalities will collect and run the court. Change appears driven by payday loan companies. Greg will look into the law regarding court appearances.
 - Municipal priorities list is being developed and council input is due by 9/1. Council members will look over their district this coming month to discuss at the next meeting. Looking for items related to sidewalk damage, lighting and signage problems, water drainage issues, ADA compliance, and park maintenance or improvement.
 - Chamber West is in discussion to improve communication with UDOT prior to project startup.
 - Immigration Comprehensive bill to improve Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) education.
 - Economic development preliminary report has no changes to the budget. The impact on the county budget from the Rio Tinto – Kennecott landslide is not yet known but will be significant.
- ACCT Report-
 - The Granite Peaks area (by La Caille restaurant) is facing annexation by Sandy City.
 - No ACCT meeting in July

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- ACCT met with Unified Fire Authority and Sandy City regarding the impact of Sandy City withdrawing from the SLC emergency call system. The withdrawal will increase response times to county areas serviced by the first responder contract with Sandy City.
- Southeast Township Days:
 - Budget is in good shape.
 - Next meeting will be held June 9th, 2013 at 7 p.m. at the White City Water offices.
 - Have reserved the new DARE car
 - SE Township Days currently has a video entered in a video contest for \$5000. The contest is open through June 30th, 2013. People go online and vote for their favorite video. If the SE Township Days video wins, Paulina proposes adding a charity component.
 - The flyer is available on her porch for those needing them to hand out.
- Other news:
 - July meeting moved to July 17th, 2013, due to the Independence Day holiday. Motioned, seconded and approved.
 - No further response on the GRAMA request for fire service budget details from Sandy City, paying \$750,000 /year. Greg suggested appealing to the fire board regarding high costs. Leave on the agenda. Paulina to invite the Unified Fire Authority leaders to July's meeting.
 - Several of the White City monuments have been vandalized or damaged. No further repairs were completed in May. The cement repairs and damaged bricks will be coordinated with the water company, which has lifting equipment, hopefully completed in June.
 - Sandy is considering pulling out of the emergency call center. This may impact White City Township emergency response times. Proposed requesting withdrawal of contract from Sandy City for First Responder if they withdraw from the emergency dispatch call center, due to an unacceptable increase in response time. Motion seconded and approved. Paulina to draft letter and send to SLCo and Unified Fire.
 - Westbound 10600 South at 1300 East has had an island installed which is causing a traffic hazard from people trying to get into or out of the McDonald's and Chevron on the Northwest corner of the intersection. Sandy City is responsible for this intersection and road area. Letter of concern should be sent to Patrick at SLCo to discuss with Sandy City.
 - Complaint was made to the council, regarding a home based business operating a paint shop. The complaint included pictures showing business operations exceeding the scope of the business license. Paulina and Greg to forward the pictures and complaint to the sewer district and business license compliance.
