MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Pledge was lead by Richard Snow.

- Approval of February 6th, 2013 Minutes- motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer's report-Jeremy Christensen gave the financial reports for February 2013. Provided account status and results of the audit. Audit found compliance with the bylaws and no evidence of misappropriation of funds. Treasurer's report motion, seconded, and approved.
- Unified Police Report- Dave Scharffs and Charlotte Halverson attending from citizens advisory board. Officer Green provided data for February 2013. Discussed impacts of vandalism at the White City Water offices.
 - Data provided by Officer Green: Total Calls: 140; Total Cases: 48
- Mayor's Report-Greg Schultz and Joel Freston. The county has received all the volunteer forms for the WCTCC representatives. Sanitation has moved to separate billing instead of on the property tax form. Salt Lake County received a gold rating for Customer service on a national ranking. Patrick is looking at doing a county wide unincorporated newsletter.
- Legislative issues discussed include S.B. 109 (regarding public water suppliers), H.B. 334 (regarding special district versus local districts), H.B. 88 (regarding changing land use authority from county to landowner).
- ACCT Report- ACCT training was moved to May 4th, 2013 at 7am at the Salt Lake County complex.
- Southeast Township Days: Requested other councils provide a resolution of support.
- Other news: Received the GRAMA request for fire service budget details from Sandy City, paying \$750,000 /year. * Some empty homes may be attempted to turn into group homes. These homes require state & county licenses. * Several residents have inquired about speed bumps on Sego Lily for traffic control. If 10 residents sign a letter and submit to the county, they will do a traffic study.
