**MINUTES**

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Pledge was lead by Richard Snow.

- Approval of April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2013 Minutes- motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer's report-none.
- Unified Police Report- none. Attending: Charlotte Halverson, Dave Scharffs
  - Data provided electronically by Officer Green: Total Calls: 168; Total Cases: 45
- Mayor's Report-Greg Schultz and Joel Freston. Delivered checks to the Chairman for SE Township Days. Joel reported proposed Granite Peaks annexation by Sandy. Discussed proposed change to the justice courts where they will be regionalized and the municipalities will collect and run the court. Change appears driven by payday loan companies. Greg will look into the law regarding court appearances. Municipal priorities list is being developed and council input is due by 9/1. Council members will look over their district this coming month to discuss at the next meeting. The impact on the county budget from the Rio Tinto – Kennecott landslide is not yet known but will be significant.
- ACCT Report- The Granite Peaks area (by La Caille restaurant) is facing annexation by Sandy City. \* Utah Neighborhoods approved 501c3 status for the Southeast Township Days event.
- Southeast Township Days: Paulina provided a copy of the flyer and will have them available on her porch for those needing them to hand out. Haven't heard from all the other townships regarding their vote to support the event. Motion for revolving funds made, seconded, and approved. Utah Neighborhoods 501c3 status approved.
- Other news: No further response on the GRAMA request for fire service budget details from Sandy City, paying \$750,000 /year. Greg suggested appealing to the fire board regarding high costs. Leave on the agenda \* Several of the White City monuments have been vandalized or damaged. Kay and Cody were successful with using the paint removers on the graffiti. The cement repairs and damaged bricks will be coordinated with the water company which has lifting equipment. \* The new carwash in the Quarry Bend area also includes a lube/oil/filter and gas station. Sandy City required source protection equipment around the facility to protect water sources. Sandy was requested to inform White City Water or WCTCC prior to approval of facilities impacting us. \* Sandy is considering pulling out of the emergency call center. This may impact White City Township emergency response times. \* Westbound 10600 South at 1300 East has had an island installed which is causing a traffic hazard from people trying to get into or out of the McDonald's and Chevron on the Northwest corner of the intersection. Linda Price to inquire of UDOT about the change and hazards.
