MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Pledge led by Christy Seiger-Webster.

- Council Excused: Paulina Flint,

- Approval of September 4th, 2013 Minutes- motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer's report- Have not yet cross checked SE Township Days account with Paulina. Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Unified Police Report- Attending: Brooks Green, Charlotte Halverson
 - Data provided electronically by Detective Green: Total Calls: 196; Total Cases: 49
- Mayor's Report- Attending: Patrick Leary, Stacey Adams, Greg Schulz, Joel Freston
 - Patrick Leary discussed new government structure with the Office of Township Services.
 - Stacey Adams, communications director, introduced herself to the committee. She is setting up Pinterest boards. The SLCo website is being revised. Working on Salt Lake County Living Magazine.
 - New grants office to assist in finding and applying for grants.
 - Jeff Gravits is the SLCo CERT / Emergency Director. He is working on a chain of command in event of a real event.
 - County officials toured White City Township on Sep. 12.
 - Engineering and Code Enforcement want to make this an annual event.
 - The repair zone for the storm drainage problem area on Carnation and Amaryllis has been expanded.
 - Recommend a tour itinerary for each attending member for future tours.
 - A proposed change to the reporting structure for county councils is being make by Mayor McAdams. A meeting will be held on Nov. 5.
- ACCT Report-
 - The current ACCT secretary has resigned and elections for a replacement will be in January.
- Southeast Township Days:
 - No items of business.
- Report on UFA and VECC issues
 - Received Sandy City budget details.
 - Sandy City claims to have spent over \$800,000, but the contract is only for \$750,000. No explanation of discrepancy.
 - White City Township is not adequately covered by services. Discuss further next month.

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- Sandy is considering pulling out of the emergency call center. A letter was sent out to SLCo and Unified Fire to cancel the first responders contract. *Leave on the agenda.*
- A meeting was held the last week in August with all stakeholders and county officials. Paulina attended. Will discuss next month.
- Southeast CERT Team
 - Linda attended the first Southeast CERT team meeting. Each member was assigned to find out resources available from different groups, such as the State, County, Fire, etc. Next meeting will be in December.
- Other Business:
 - County proposed ordinance change for allowing “food animals” (i.e. livestock not pets). White City Township does not have any areas that qualify under this ordinance. WCTCC has no opinion on this change.
 - Several of the White City monuments have been vandalized or damaged. No further repairs have been completed. The cement repairs and damaged bricks will be coordinated with the water company, which has lifting equipment. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - Westbound 10600 South at 1300 East has had an island installed which is causing a traffic hazard from people trying to get into or out of the McDonald’s and Chevron on the Northwest corner of the intersection. Sandy City is responsible for this intersection and road area. Letter of concern should be sent to Patrick at SLCo to discuss with Sandy City. Discussion tabled until next meeting. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - White City Water has been notified about an increase in fees from the State water board. Council motion: “The State agency should go through appropriations of the state instead of fees to local agencies.” Seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
