MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Pledge of Allegiance by Richard Snow.
- Council Attendees: Kay Dickerson, Christy Seiger-Webster, Jeremy Christensen, Lenelle Sanchez, Richard Snow, Darrin Webster, Cody Cutler, Paulina Flint and Linda Price.
- Council Excused: none
- Council Not Excused: none
- Visitors: Steve Wrigley, Jeffery Summerhays
- Approval of August 13th, 2014 Minutes – Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer’s report – Motion, seconded, and approved. SE Township days had a net loss for the year.
- Unified Police Report - Attending: Brooks Green.
 - Data provided electronically by Detective Green: Total Calls: 127; Total Cases: 45
- Mayor’s Report - Attending: Greg Schultz.
 - Need the preliminary budget for 2015 by the end of September.
- ACCT Report -
 - Sandy City completed annexation of Willow Creek.
 - Forrest Service provided information on fire risks and pine beetle infestations.
- Southeast Township Days:
 - Event was successful.
 - Lessons Learned meeting will be September 5 at White City Water.
 - Thank you to all that helped.
- Report on UFA and VECC issues (no changes reported at this meeting)
 - Received Sandy City budget details.
 - Sandy City claims to have spent over \$800,000, but the contract is only for \$750,000. No explanation of discrepancy.
 - White City Township is not adequately covered by services. Discuss further next month.
 - White City Township has contributed \$346,544 to the UFA budget. Still don’t know how it is spent.
 - Sandy is considering pulling out of the emergency call center. A letter was sent out to SLCo and Unified Fire to cancel the first responders contract. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - One White City resident experienced significant delays for emergency response due to the two call centers not agreeing. This is an example of the concerns WCTCC has had during this whole discussion. The call centers say they will resolve with additional training. A Draper City man died waiting for response following 911 delay. Mayor McAdams working with Brad Dee to sponsor a bill to require a consolidated 911 system. *Leave on the agenda and review in a few months.*
 - A meeting was held the last week in August with all stakeholders and county officials. Paulina attended.

- A meeting was held with UFA Chief Jensen, UFA ACCT liaison Anderton, and others regarding the first response contract with Sandy City. Chief Jensen to investigate why payments in excess of the contract value were made and re-assess the contract. Follow up in March.
- Told Nicole Dunn and UFA that delays and any withdrawal from VECC and WCTCC would withdraw from UFA. White City continues to have issues with this situation. *Leave on the agenda.*
- Other Business:
 - White City Water has been notified about an increase in fees from the State water board. Council motion: “The State agency should go through appropriations of the state instead of fees to local agencies.” Seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - Willow Canyon Annex – Paulina will forward a PowerPoint put together by Willow Canyon which goes over Sandy City cash equivalence accounts, franchise taxes and other hidden costs to being a Sandy City resident.
 - Sandy City has posted a Notice of Public Hearing for July 17, 2014 at 6:15 at the Sandy City Planning Commission. Basis is Sandy City is providing services to them.
 - Motion to file a complaint with the SLCo Attorney regarding Sandy City using Fire and EMT service, which is under sub-contract with SLCo, as grounds for annexation under UAC 10-2-418. Seconded and approved. Paulina to draft.
 - Election committee was nominated as all council members not up for election: Linda Price, chair; Darrin Webster, co-chair; Lenelle Sanchez, and Christy Seiger-Webster.
 - Need to do notices and calendar and candidate applications.
 - Each WCTCC district representative should report on the district’s current lighting and whether it is functional. Due in October.
 - Wasatch Front Recycling – Attending: Jeffery Summerhays
 - Recycling offsets fees for waste removal and disposal and extends the life of the landfill.
 - The SLCo Mayor is pushing to increase recycling in SLCo.
 - Jeffrey will send information about tours and copies of fliers.
 - Canyons School District - Attending: Steve Wrigley
 - Planning a new elementary school in White City, options of Alta View, Edgemont, and Bellview
 - The board recommends Alta View as it is the oldest building and in the most need of repairs.
 - Next will be a town hall meeting by the school district to be held in October.
 - There is a Meet the Superintendent meeting at Silver Mesa on September 5 at 7 pm.
- Council Matters: Secretary needs to go with the Treasurer to the Bank and get added to the accounts.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:24 pm.
