MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. No flag available for the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Council Attendees: Kay Dickerson, Christy Seiger-Webster, Richard Snow, Lenelle Sanchez, Cody Cutler.
- Council Excused: Jeremy Christensen, Linda Price and Paulina Flint
- Council Not Excused: none
- Visitors: none
- Approval of August 5, 2015 Minutes – Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer’s report – no report.
- Unified Police Report – Attending: None.
 - Data provided by Detective Green: Total Calls: 115; Total Cases: 35
 - Illegal passing has been occurring on Carnation. Asked Detective Green to investigate.
- Senate Bill 199 (Community Preservation Elections)
 - Elections Timeline: 2015-vote on boundary/status and municipal services; 2016 election of new council/government; 2017-implementation of new council/government.
 - Upcoming 2015 election residents of White City Township will have the option to vote to be a “Metro” Township or to form a City.
 - Upcoming 2015 election residents of White City Township will vote whether to keep SLCo Municipal Services (All county services except garbage).
 - Information, as available from SLCo, was condensed into an article included in the newsletter. Information is available on the SLCo website.
 - Information on financial implications of SB 199 are due September 6, 2015.
 - The original proposed boundaries for some of the other SLCo unincorporated areas are very different from the existing boundaries. The Magna boundaries designated for the election have been modified to nearly their original boundaries. The Copperton boundaries designated for the election have been increased but not really by much. Communities are still trying to restore/modify boundaries designated for the election.
 - The ballot language was distributed and references “planning districts”. A legal opinion on the language is due July 14, 2015. Planning district language is official.
 - Town hall meeting for White City will be held on September 25, 2015 from 6:30-8:30 pm at Eastmont Middle School to inform voters and answer questions about the upcoming election.
- Mayor’s Report - Attending: None.

 - The West Side Councils met to prioritize Greg Schultz’s work, since they hired him. SLCo Mayor’s Office says Greg is their employee and they control his work priorities. *Leave on the agenda.*

- The framework of the new Municipal Services District should be available by August 1, 2015.
- Proposed changes to ACCT bylaws based on motion for ACCT purpose after SB199 elections: Add “metro” township and municipal services district and other minor procedural changes.
- SLCo wide 911 system is being implemented to standardize across Fire and Police and across Cities and unincorporated SLCo and will support cell phones.
- Report on UFA and VECC issues (no changes reported at this meeting; See previous meeting minutes for details.) *Leave on the agenda.*
- Emergency Preparedness – Attending: none
 - Add an emergency information tab to the website. *Leave on the agenda.*
- Southeast Township Days
 - Another successful year. Paulina thanks everyone.
 - Car Show – add another category next year (Motorcycles?); Kay forwarded a comment about car show judging
 - Food vendors – 6 registered and 3 showed
 - Recommend magnetic signs to label WCTCC/SE Township Days vehicles and trailers.
- Other Business:
 - SLCo has a new info-graphic poster showing the demographics of White City Township. Kay to look into obtaining copies and also showing at SE Township Days.
 - White City Water has been notified about an increase in fees from the State water board. Council motion: “The State agency should go through appropriations of the state instead of fees to local agencies.” Seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - Motion to perform a survey with USU on the resident’s beliefs/opinions on community services and government structure. Motion seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
- Council Matters:
 - Secretary needs to go with the Treasurer to the Bank and get added to the accounts.
 - Darrin Webster (At-Large C) submitted a letter resignation. He is now working outside of SLCo and is not able to attend any WCTCC meetings or events. Motion: The WCTCC will accept nominations for candidates to fill the At-Large C council position. Provide names to Kay Dickerson, Council Chair.
