MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Richard Snow led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Council Attendees: Kay Dickerson, Christy Seiger-Webster, Richard Snow, Jeremy Christensen, Linda Price, Lenelle Sanchez, Cody Cutler, and Paulina Flint.
- Council Excused: none
- Council Not Excused: none
- Visitors: Ron Faerber
- Approval of October 7, 2015 Minutes, with corrected spelling – Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer’s report – Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Unified Police Report – Attending: none.
 - Data provided by Detective Green: Total Calls: 364; Total Cases: 42.
- Senate Bill 199 (Community Preservation Elections)
 - Elections Timeline: 2015-vote on boundary/status and municipal services; 2016 election of new council/government; 2017-implementation of new council/government.
 - Information, as available from SLCo, was condensed into an article included in the newsletter. Information is available on the SLCo website. SLCo refused reimbursement of WCTCC funds for newsletter.
 - Information on financial implications of SB 199 only contains information on the financial implications of the Municipal Services district.
 - Election was held on November 3, 2015. Preliminary results show WCT residents voted to be a Metro Township and remain with the Municipal Services District. The final election results will be available on November 17, 2015.
 - Districting Maps for the 2016 election are available for public comment. WCT has 5 districts. The 5th district is in pieces along both sides of Dimple Dell.
 - Motion: WCTCC opposes the proposed district boundaries for the White City Metro Township and we urge SLCo to revisit the district mapping in the upcoming SB199 amendments to allow At-Large council member positions. Motion was seconded and approved unanimously.
- Mayor’s Report - Attending: none.
 - See section on SB 199
 - The West Side Councils met to prioritize Greg Schultz’s work, since they hired him. SLCo Mayor’s Office says Greg is their employee and they control his work priorities. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - The 2016 budget is needed by October 26, 2015. Motion to ask for a 20% budget increase from last year. Seconded and approved.
- ACCT Report -
 - ACCT held its annual meeting with the SLCo council on September 29, 2015. Paulina and Kay submitted written questions. Written answers were received from the SLCo Council.

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- ACCT needs volunteers to serve on the election nominating committee.
- Report on UFA and VECC issues (no changes reported at this meeting; See previous meeting minutes for details.) *Leave on the agenda.*
- Emergency Preparedness – Attending: Janice Kerby
 - Add an emergency information tab to the website. *Leave on the agenda.*
- Other Business:
 - White City Water has been notified about an increase in fees from the State water board. Council motion: “The State agency should go through appropriations of the state instead of fees to local agencies.” Seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - Motion to perform a survey with USU on the resident’s beliefs/opinions on community services and government structure. Motion seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - Paulina and Kay met with residents and SLCo representatives at 9400 South and Quarry Bend Road (the “S” curve where 9000 South turns into 9400 South) to discuss a sidewalk on the north side of the road. Pedestrians, including one resident in a mobility scooter, have to walk in the roadway along this section. Paulina will contact the property owner. SLCo will determine the fair market value of the property needed for a sidewalk. SLCo provided a preliminary drawing of the proposed sidewalk.
 - SLCo moving forward on building a trail along the old canal. They are looking at adding speed bumps on Galena Drive where the trail will cross over to Edgemont Elementary.
 - Kay and Paulina met with SLCo regarding the asphalt grade on Carnation Drive. This project will be added to next year’s budget and will include new gutters.
- Council Matters:
 - Secretary needs to go with the Treasurer to the Bank and get added to the accounts.
 - Council needs to determine if the community council will remain as an advisory board following the election of the township council.
 - Community council members can run for Township Council.
