### MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Richard Snow led the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Council Excused: Jeremy Christensen, Michelle Flinders
- Council Not Excused: Lenelle Sanchez
- Visitors: Scout Troop 375 with Scoutmaster David Snow
- Approval of January 6, 2016 Minutes – Motion to approve with typographical changes, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer’s report – no report
- Unified Police Report – Attending: none
  - Data provided by Detective Green: Total Calls: 118; Total Cases: 31.
  - Car thefts increased due to people leaving their cars idling unattended.
- Mayor’s Report - Attending: Greg Shultz.
  - The West Side Councils met to prioritize Greg Schultz’s work, since they hired him. SLCo Mayor’s Office says Greg is their employee and they control his work priorities. *Leave on the agenda.*
  - Township Services leadership is Kim Barnett as General Manager handling community preservation and other political issues and Russ Wall handling Public Works Services and operations activities.
  - MSD (Municipal Services District) Interlocal agreement draft will go to the SLCo Council for approval on February 9, 2016.
  - The volunteer community council will remain in place unless the community decides to disband it.
  - The election information is available to run for the Metro Township Council. The deadline to apply is March 17, 2016.
  - Under the new Metro Township there will be a planning commission. Need 7-9 volunteers to participate. Can not serve on planning commission and on township council.
  - If aware of additional municipal projects needed in our area, please let the community council know.
  - Motion to ask SLCo for a waiver of WCTCC elections this year due to other elections. Seconded and approved.
- ACCT Report -
  - SLCo Council approved the ACCT MSD Advisory Board with one representative from each community.
  - ACCT supports new legislation to make At-Large Districting for communities smaller than 10,000 residents. LaVar Christensen to sponsor.

  - White City Water has been notified about an increase in fees from the State water board. Council motion: “The State agency should go through appropriations of the state instead of fees to local agencies.” Seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
  - Motion to perform a survey with USU on the resident’s beliefs/opinions on community services and government structure. Motion seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
  - SLCo moving forward on building a trail along the old canal. They are looking at adding speed bumps on Galena Drive where the trail will cross over to Edgemont Elementary.
  - Motion to move the March 2, 2016 meeting to March 9, 2016, since three council members will be unavailable. Seconded and approved.
- Southeast Township Days: Had 107 cars at last year’s show. Emailed notices to previous booth vendors to begin signups for this year.
- Council Matters:
  - Secretary needs to go with the Treasurer to the Bank and get added to the accounts.
  - Council needs to determine if the community council will remain as an advisory board following the election of the township council.
  - Community co:uncil members can run for Township Council.
