### MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Kay Dickerson led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- Council Attendees: Kay Dickerson, Christy Seiger-Webster, Linda Price, Jeremy Christensen, Cody Cutler, and Paulina Flint.
- Council Excused: Lenelle Sanchez
- Council Not Excused: Richard Snow
- Visitors: none
- Approval of February 3, 2016 Minutes – Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer’s report – no report
- Unified Police Report – Attending: none
  - Data provided by Detective Green: Total Calls: 118; Total Cases: 31.
  - Detective Green has been promoted and will no longer be our community liaison. Paulina has been asked to participate in interviews for his replacement.
  - Motion to send a letter of thanks to Detective Brooks for his service to our community. Seconded and approved.
- Mayor’s Report - Attending: Greg Shultz.
  - The West Side Councils met to prioritize Greg Schultz’s work, since they hired him. SLCo Mayor’s Office says Greg is their employee and they control his work priorities. *Leave on the agenda.*
  - Township Services leadership is Kim Barnett as General Manager handling community preservation and other political issues and Russ Wall handling Public Works Services and operations activities.
  - The volunteer community council will remain in place unless the community decides to disband it.
  - The White City Metro Township Council positions have 12 candidates registered.
  - Under the new Metro Township there will be a planning commission. Need 7-9 volunteers to participate. Can not serve on planning commission and on township council.
    - Motion to propose Christy Seiger-Webster for the planning commission. Seconded and approved.
  - If aware of additional municipal projects needed in our area, please let the community council know.
  - Motion to ask SLCo for a waiver of WCTCC elections this year due to other elections. Seconded and approved.
- ACCT Report -
  - SLCo Council approved the ACCT MSD Advisory Board with one representative from each community.
  - ACCT supports new legislation to make At-Large Districting for communities smaller than 10,000 residents. The bill passed and is going to the governor for signature.

  - White City Water has been notified about an increase in fees from the State water board. Council motion: “The State agency should go through appropriations of the state instead of fees to local agencies.” Seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
  - Motion to perform a survey with USU on the resident’s beliefs/opinions on community services and government structure. Motion seconded and approved. *Leave on the agenda.*
  - SLCo moving forward on building a trail along the old canal. They are looking at adding speed bumps on Galena Drive where the trail will cross over to Edgemont Elementary.
  - Motion to produce a newsletter containing information about upcoming emergency preparedness activities, the metro township election and list registered candidates, MSD information, Southeast Township Days information, and the new Unified Police community liaison (if available by press time). Seconded and approved.
- Southeast Township Days: Car show and vendor sign up is available.
- Council Matters:
  - Secretary needs to go with the Treasurer to the Bank and get added to the accounts.
  - Council needs to determine if the community council will remain as an advisory board following the election of the township council.
  - Michelle Flinders submitted her resignation to the council. Motion to accept the resignation. Seconded and approved.
