### MINUTES

- Approval of March 9, 2016 Minutes – Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer’s report – Motion, seconded, and approved.
- Unified Police Report – Attending: Detective Paula Stinson
  - Data provided by Detective Stinson: Total Calls: 101; Total Cases: 40.
  - Detective Stinson is our new community liaison.
  - Best thing to do with community tips is to call Unified Police Dispatch.
- Mayor’s Report - Attending: George Deneris with SLCo Engineering.

    - Motion to ask SLCo to set aside documents developed to date on the Mountain Accord and abandon current Federal District designation until such time as all Public Notices and Hearings and Comment Periods are exhausted. Seconded and approved.

  - Add an emergency information tab to the website. *Leave on the agenda.*
  - Great Shake Out will be held April 21, 2016.
  - CERT drill scheduled for September 2016.
- Other Business:
