MINUTES

- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Pledge of Allegiance led by Darrin Webster.
- Council Attendees: Kay Dickerson, Christy Seiger-Webster, Cody Cutler, Jeremy Christensen, Richard Snow, Linda Price, and Paulina Flint.
- Council Excused: Lenelle Sanchez
- Council Not Excused: None
- Visitors: Allan Perry and Dave Scharffs
- Approval of May 4, 2016 Minutes – Motion to approve with edits, seconded, and approved.
- Treasurer’s report – Motion, seconded, and approved.
 - Kay and Paulina to go to US Bank to stop the service charges that are occurring again.
- Unified Police Report – Attending: Detective Paula Stinson
 - Data provided by Detective Stinson: Total Calls: 122; Total Cases: 35.
- Mayor’s Report - Attending: Greg Schultz.
 - The West Side Councils met to prioritize Greg Schultz’s work, since they hired him. SLCo Mayor’s Office says Greg is their employee and they control his work priorities. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - SLCo still considering WCTCC request for a waiver of WCTCC elections this year due to other elections. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - Russ Wall is leaving SLCo Public Works. Motion to send a letter of appreciation for his service to him and copy the Mayor and Council. Seconded and Approved.
 - Rick Graham is the new Township Manager and Municipal Services District Manager.
 - Paulina was contacted by Wayne Johnson about redoing the Big Bear Park sidewalks that are heaving. They do not have formal plans yet, but wanted our opinion since some options will require removing trees. General opinion is to save as many of the trees as possible but replacing the heaving concrete is recommended.
 - Motion to rescind the April 2016 recommendation regarding the bike lane. WCTCC recommends keeping the turn lane and re-routing the bike lanes due to heavy traffic along Segoe Lily due to the schools. Seconded and approved.
 - WCTCC needs to turn in any requests for municipal services for next year to SLCo. Council member should forward items to Paulina. (examples are additional street lights, additional street signs, etc.)
- ACCT Report –
 - Cost for recycling service may begin. They are receiving too many items that are not recyclable. Example is the plastic grocery sacks. Retail stores recycle them, but individual bags will clog the recycle sorting machines.
 - The mountain accord process is re-starting to involve the public. The stated goal is to balance wilderness area protection with usage. This does not include any expansion of the wilderness area.
- Emergency Preparedness – Attending: Janice Kerby

- CERT drill scheduled for September 2016.
- Other Business:
 - SLCo moving forward on building a trail along the old canal. They are looking at adding speed bumps on Galena Drive where the trail will cross over to Edgemont Elementary.
 - Articles for the summer newsletter are due June 10, 2016. All candidates for the Metro Township Council can submit a half page article and picture for inclusion in the newsletter.
- Southeast Township Days:
 - Car show and vendor sign up is available.
 - Flyer is ready to distribute. Pick up at Paulina's house.
 - Need to apply for the health permit.
 - Need to arrange for off duty officers to assist with the car show.
 - Need to start recruiting volunteers to assist at the event.
 - Signs will go up the last week in July. Volunteers to hang signs are needed.
- Council Matters:
 - Christy Seiger-Webster will not be serving on the Planning Commission.
 - Secretary needs to go with the Treasurer to the Bank and get added to the accounts.
 - Council needs to determine if the community council will remain as an advisory board following the election of the township council.
