- Meeting called to order by Kay Dickerson, Chair, there was a quorum. Richard Snow led the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Visitors: Scout troops 375 and 3375
- Approval of October 4, 2017 Minutes – Motion, seconded and approved.
- Treasurer’s report – Motion, seconded and approved.
 - Motion to ask SLCo for the entire Southeast Township Days event budget, rather than working through all the different community councils. *Leave on agenda.*
 - Motion pay the annual fee for the Webmaster, seconded, and approved.
- Unified Police Report – Paula Stinson
 - Total Calls: 98; Total Cases: 55.
 - Ongoing issues:
 - Upswing in vehicle burglaries and theft of items from yards.
 - Chief Mazuran promoted. New chief is Randy Thomas.
- White City Township Metro Council (WCTMC) Report –
 - Will hold a budget hearing on December 14, 2017.
 - Planning and Zoning is holding meetings on December 19, January 9, and January 23 to work on the draft Master plan.
- White City Township Community Council (WCTCC) –
 - Added a tab to the WCTCC website to link to the WCTMC website.
 - Discuss appointing additional members of the WCTCC to fill vacancies at December meeting. Need a new representative from District #5 (replace Jeremy Christensen) and replace those members now serving on the Metro Council. Need to look into advertising/getting the word out. Included in the newsletter. *Leave on agenda.*
- Greater Salt Lake Municipal Services District (GSLMSD) and other services –
 - Will hold a budget hearing on December 13, 2017.
 - SLCo Engineering current and upcoming projects (*Leave on the agenda*):
 - Sego Lily Drive traffic study – to account for the change in traffic pattern resultant from Sandy City removing the traffic light near the Sandy Library and the new pedestrian bridge. Short term they are adding more crossing guards at the cross-walks across Sego Lily Drive. Public meeting result is resident’s consensus is they don’t want the road restriped. They are concerned about the existing traffic issues and the bike path will make things worse. Suggest adding sidewalks along Sego Lily.
 - SLCo moving forward on building a trail along the old canal. They are looking at adding speed bumps on Galena Drive where the trail will cross over to Edgemont Elementary. *Leave on the agenda.*

- The Mountain Accord is being disbanded and replaced with an interlocal agreement called the Central Wasatch Commission. The stated goals are protecting the water shed, transportation improvements, and funding sources. *Leave on the agenda.*
 - Motion: WCTCC go on record as opposing the Central Wasatch Commission. Seconded and approved.
 - Central Wasatch Commission is currently with a state legislative committee which is reviewing it and wants to know why the state was initially bypassed. ACCT will continue to monitor.
