### MINUTES

- Minutes – Minutes from December 6, 2017 not available, postponed to February 2018.
- Treasurer's report – Motion, seconded and approved.
  - Motion to pay dues to ACCT and Utah Neighborhoods.
  - Motion to ask SLCo for the entire Southeast Township Days event budget, rather than working through all the different community councils. *Leave on agenda.*
- Unified Police Report – Paula Stinson
  - Data not available at the time of the meeting.
- White City Township Metro Council (WCTMC) Report –
  - Will be adopting new volunteer/conflict of interest forms at the next meeting. WCTCC will need to fill out the new forms.
  - Planning and Zoning is holding meetings on January 9 and January 23 to work on the draft Master plan. Plan to present draft at the February 2018 WCTMC meeting.
- White City Township Community Council (WCTCC) –
  - Discuss appointing additional members of the WCTCC to fill vacancies at December meeting. Need a new representative from District #5 (replace Jeremy Christensen) and replace those members now serving on the Metro Council. Need to look into advertising/getting the word out. Included in the newsletter. *Leave on agenda.*
- Greater Salt Lake Municipal Services District (GSLMSD) and other services –
  - New contacts list for different SLCo services was handed out.
  - SLCo Engineering current and upcoming projects (*Leave on the agenda*):
    - Segó Lily Drive traffic study – to account for the change in traffic pattern resultant from Sandy City removing the traffic light near the Sandy Library and the new pedestrian bridge. Short term they are adding more crossing guards at the cross-walks across Segó Lily Drive. Public meeting result is resident's consensus is they don't want the road restriped. They are concerned about the existing traffic issues and the bike path will make things worse. Suggest adding sidewalks along Segó Lily.

- SLCo moving forward on building a trail along the old canal. They are looking at adding speed bumps on Galena Drive where the trail will cross over to Edgemont Elementary. *Leave on the agenda.*
  - A walk through of the different stakeholders will be scheduled.
  - Funding is becoming controversial. According to a stormwater agreement Sandy can use the canal for 8 more years for stormwater discharge.
- ACCT Report –
  - ACCT looking for candidates to run for ACCT Officers.
  - Annual training event will be January 20, 2018 at the SLCo offices.
  - The Mountain Accord is being disbanded and replaced with an interlocal agreement called the Central Wasatch Commission. The stated goals are protecting the water shed, transportation improvements, and funding sources. *Leave on the agenda.*
    - Motion: WCTCC go on record as opposing the Central Wasatch Commission. Seconded and approved.
    - Central Wasatch Commission is currently with a state legislative committee which is reviewing it and wants to know why the state was initially bypassed. ACCT will continue to monitor.
